Dear Members and Friends,

There is good news and there is hope!

The GOOD news is that the Search Committee has done the job that the Board of Trustees charged them with: they found us a minister!

The GOOD news is that our Negotiating Team has the new Minister under contract.

The HOPE is in the Interim Stewardship Drive so that UUCD can Pay the New Minister a salary. At the 2019 UUCD Annual Meeting, the Congregation passed a Balanced Budget after an almost \$10,000 shortage because of the low total pledges.

The HOPE is that each UUCD Member and Friend will reassess their 2019-2020 pledge and increase their pledge as personal budgets allow. A few dates to be marking on your calendar: October 13th we will have a pizza party after church to kick off this interim stewardship drive. Please plan to attend and bring your revised pledge amount with you.
